UNDERSTANDING MEASLES: PREVENTION AND AWARENESS



What is Measles?

A highly contagious virus that causes a serious disease, especially in children.

Transmission

Measles spreads through respiratory droplets from coughing or sneezing. The Virus can stay in the air for up to two hours after an infected person leaves an area.

Think you've been exposed or have symptoms?

- Call the clinic or ER before arriving to get instructions.
- You may be asked to stay in your vehicle to help protect other patients.
- Limit contact with others, especially infants, pregnant women, and those with weakened immune systems.
- Watch for symptoms like high fever, cough, runny nose, red eyes, and rash.
- Avoid public places until you've been cleared by a healthcare provider.

Vaccination

Talk to your healthcare provider about the MMR Vaccine.

- First dose at 12-15 months
- Second dose 4-6 Years

- Cough
- Runny Nose
- Red, Watery Eyes
- Rash
